Exciting Changes to our Summer Show in 2016

This year we have made more changes than usual to the Show Schedule since our new venue is smaller than it was at Aston Clinton School. We aim to use the one large room adjacent to the 'Cafe in the Park' and also our marquee for the Show itself. I must admit I did count the number of entrants who entered each class throughout the whole Show for the last 4 years and I am sure you can understand why a few of the more poorly supported classes have not been included in this schedule.

One group of classes with very poor support were those in *Novice Flower* and *Novice Vegetable* sections. These sections are therefore no longer part of the schedule but we do believe that we should be encouraging novices to enter our Show. For this reason you will see that there is a Novice class within both the Vegetable and Flower sections of the Show and each has its own dedicated cup.

Here are a few key details:-

- Class 31 Novice Mini Collection. This is a vegetable class for novices with an associated cup. Details on p23. This is a great way to begin showing vegetables.
- Class 69 Novice Class Bowl of Mixed Garden Flowers. This would be a good class to begin with if you have never showed flowers before, and you could win a cup!
- Class 70 Novice Class. This year this will be an arrangement in a jug. This could be a good way to try a flower arranging class for the first time.
- Classes 142 & 143 the adult photography classes are entitled 'Wildlife' so see what you can do between now and the Show.
- Class 134 in the older children's section, the photograph needed is entitled 'In the Woods'. Do see whether you can encourage children between 9 and 14 years old to enter this class.
- For those of you who have an allotment on Aston Clinton Park we are once again judging the **best allotment** and the prize for this is a year's free rent. Good luck to all allotment holders. We also award the Rolfe Cup to the lucky winner.

And finally, please do support us in our new venue this year, we would be delighted to see you there. And remember **Entry Night is on August 17th between 6pm and 7.45pm in the Anthony Hall** and that is the last time to return any cups you won last year!
